

2008 GOLF

WEDNESDAY NIGHT RADISSON GREENS MEMBERS LEAGUE

1. **LEAGUE PLAY:** starts April 30 and will consist of 17 weeks of golf. The league schedule will be sent under separate attachment. We will be having a practice night on April 23 – weather permitting.
2. **TEE TIMES:** 4:00 – 6:00 **Competitive play must be during league times.** The weekly schedule provides the team match-ups for the week. When you and your opponent are both at the course, go to the tee box and find another twosome and get in line to tee off. As a courtesy to your opponent and other members, please contact each other prior to the match and establish an approximate time of arrival.
3. **COST:** A mandatory \$55.00 League fee will be collected from each player, to be used for a weekly skins game (\$50/wk). Checks should be made payable to “Dan Mordaunt”. Cash will NOT be accepted. There will be an envelope at the Pro Shop to drop off your check. The league fee must be paid by April 25th. Subs will **NOT** be eligible for skins.

4. PRIZES

Skins: A weekly skins match will be played each league night = \$60/wk. Skins will be broken up into two pots. The first two flights (A & B) will compete for 1 pot (\$30/wk) and the second two flights (C & D) will compete for the other pot (\$30/wk). Skins will be paid for Par’s or better only. In case of no winners all of the skin money will carry over to the next week.

There will NOT be a Closest to the Pin prize: The money previously reserved for closest to the pin will be added to SKINS.

League Prizes: The league will be broken up into 2 sessions (8 weeks each) so there will be a payout for each session. The breakdown is as follows:

1st place = \$30.00

2nd place = \$20.00

3rd place = \$12.50

4th place = \$7.50

Standings for the year will also be kept with a small payout (\$15) going to the overall season leader.

5. **PLAYING RULES:** Play in accordance USGA rules with the following league modifications:

Winter Rules

You may clean and place the ball in **your own fairway only**. If you want to adjust the lie in any other situation you can declare it unplayable and take a 1-stroke penalty unless the normal rules of golf apply (i.e. casual water).

Senior players

If you are 65 years of age or older and “NORMALLY” play from the yellow tees, you may continue to do so during League play.

6. **SPEED OF PLAY:** Let’s do our best to keep the pace of play moving. Be ready to play when it is your turn and play ready golf as much as possible. Nobody wants to feel rushed, but nobody likes waiting on every shot either. Let’s be courteous.

7. **CONCEDING PUTTS:** All par or better putts must be putted out since everyone is in the skins game. ALSO, no pick-ups on any putts unless opponent tells you to pick up.

8. **POINT SCORING:** Each player plays for himself and for a maximum of 20 points per week determined as follows.

2 points per hole.	= 18 points
2 points for most holes won	= 02 points

Total	= 20 points

9. **FORFEIT MATCHES:** If a player or sub does not show up to play by 5:50 (or last foursome is ready to start) the match is considered a forfeit. The opponent must still play to earn points. Players will play against the course with handicap. 2 points will be awarded for low net, plus 1 point will be awarded for each net par (basically a tie with the course) or 2 points will be awarded for each net birdie or better (beating the course) using your entire handicap. The absent player receives 0 points for the night.

10. **MATCHES/STANDINGS:** The League will consist of 4 Flights (A thru D). There will be two separate seasons and an overall season standing.

Everyone should end up playing against someone of similar abilities. Therefore, strokes “ARE NOT” given within your Flight. Finally, the 8th week will be position night.

11. **SUBS:** Please arrange for subs if you cannot play. A sub list will be provided as a suggested source. However if mutually agreed upon, you may schedule your match on the previous Tuesday or following Thursday of the week eligible for play. This exception can only be used once per half and requires prior notification to Dan Mordaunt or Chris Austin. Additionally, Subs shall be a member with a handicap within the same flight they are playing. The sub can only play in one match per week and are NOT eligible for any weekly prize money.

12. **HANDICAP:** There will be four flights and 12 members in each flight. There will be no strokes given within your flight.

13. **RAIN OUTS:** The **league plays rain or shine, unless the course closes**, always come prepared to play. If play has started and is halted because of inclement weather, all matches for a flight must be completed or all matches must be replayed. The decision to stop play is determined by the league chairman. If play can continue all attempts should be made to finish your match.

14. **SCORE CARDS:** All cards must be signed and turned in Wednesday night to the front desk prior to leaving the course. If they are not turned in by the end of the evening, both players forfeit match points.

15. **THE FINAL WEEK OF GOLF:** there will be some type of team tournament to be determined at a later date. Subs cannot be used for final week. The league fee does not cover prize money for the last week. All prize money for league standings will be awarded after.
